Fruitland is committed to a proactive community that focuses on achieving unity, maintaining quality of life and progressive move forward using wireless broadband.

The previous communication network was using the 3.65 GHz WiMAX frequency that was not operating reliably. The residents of these counties needed reliable broadband in their homes. The long distances between houses and access points, typical for a rural environment, as well as near-line of site (NLOS) territories with trees created challenges in picking the right equipment.

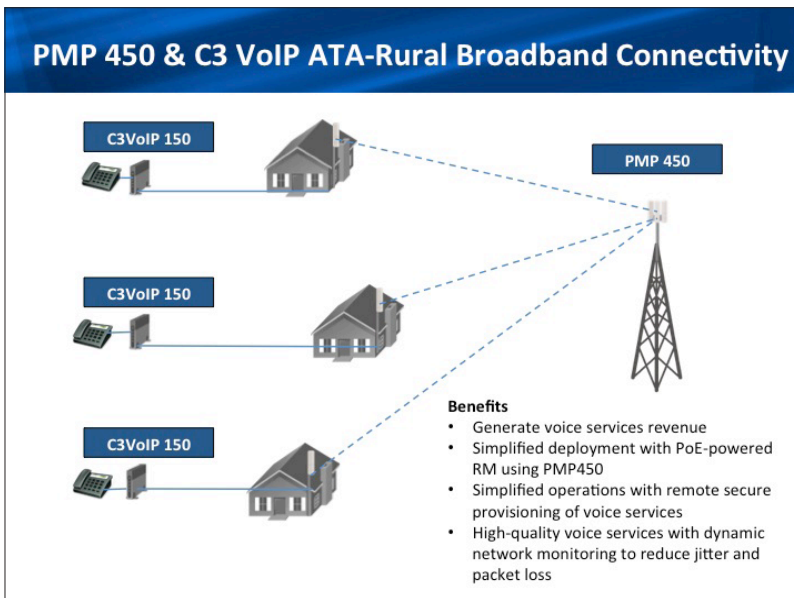
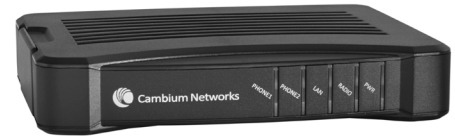
Solution

- Offer a reliable VoIP solution to customers in one package
- Operate in difficult near-line of site (nLOS) environments at long distances
- Use unlicensed 2.4 GHz frequency band
- Flexibility to open up wider channels to achieve higher bandwidth

The new system was very efficient and easy to deploy. As an added bonus, the platform offers the ability to easily expand as the community grows.

The city of Fruitland and nearby provinces received “metropolitan” quality voice coverage in a typical rural community. The system configuration and installation went flawlessly.
